**3 PIECES OF PROPERTY THAT I'M NOT WILLING TO PUT A "FOR SALE" SIGN ON!  
I Kings 21:3**

And Naboth said to Ahab, The LORD forbid it me, that I should give the inheritance of my fathers unto thee.

In the book of I Kings chapter 21 we find Ahab covets Naboth's vineyard.

This chapter could be effortlessly outlined like this:

- I. Ahab's Conspiracy. (verses 1-16)
- II. Ahab's Condemnation. (verses 17-24)
- III. Ahab's Contrition. (verses 25-29)

It is while the unknown writer is dealing (under the direct inspiration of the Holy Spirit) with "Ahab's Conspiracy" that a person reads where the good man, Naboth, tells the bad man, Ahab, plainly, "My father's land is NOT FOR SALE!" (VERSE 3)

Most Bible students feel that this also was the family's home-stead. (Lev. 25:23-28)

Someone has said, "The King thought every man had his price, but Naboth was not for sale."

Friend, you and I (those of us that labour in the Lord's orchard) should have some ground we are not going to get rid of!

There are three spiritual "vineyards" that as a servant of God, I must never sell. (All found in II Timothy)

**I. MY BIBLE.**

A spiritual "vineyard" that as a servant of God I must never sell, is my Bible. (II Timothy 3:16) Today a perdition-bent world, a sin drunk nation and a pseudo-intelligent clergy are doing their best to get the christian to peddle off their Holy Manual of Faith and Practice. The devil knows if he can just get you to DIS-BELIEVE the Word of God, you will soon DEPART from the Word of God! (Genesis 3:1, 6 & 8) My Bible!

**II. MY BAPTIST ORDINATION.**

A spiritual "vineyard" that as a servant of God I must never sell, is my Baptist Ordination. (II Timothy 1:6) When looking at the cherished document of September 26, 1981 recently, I was reminded of my sacred connect to the fundamental church, the fundamental comrades and the fundamental cause. **III. MY BELIEFS.**
